The Bottom Ling The cost of a 4-H or FFA animal project is higher than

that of a commercial stockman because of the individual attention given to that animal's development. This special attention deserves a premium price above the market price. The "break even" cost will allow the exhibitors to earn a profit margin that can be reinvested into next year's project or put away for college.
