Marty Stuart to Perform at Tulare County Fair

TULARE – Four-time Grammy award winner Marty Stuart will perform at the Tulare County Fair on Sunday, Sept. 20.

All Budweiser Stage concerts are free with Fair admission.

Stuart began his career singing gospel as a child, performed bluegrass with Lester Flatt in the '70s, spent six years with Johnny Cash in the '80s and developed his hit-making "hillbilly rock" sound in the '90s. In addition to touring, today Stuart can also be seen on the RFD-TV "Marty Stuart Show."

His hits include "Hillbilly Rock," "Western Girls," "Tempted" and, his biggest hit, "The Whiskey Ain't Workin'."
