



2020 Tulare County Fair

Dairy Heifer Sale

- If you entered a heifer and a JLA animal, you could still sell the JLA animal if it is deemed market ready/market acceptable.
- The Dairy Heifer Sale will take place at the **Tulare Sales Yard located at 4013 S K Street, Tulare, CA 93274, Thursday, September 17th. Heifers need to arrive at 4:00pm Sale will begin at 6pm.**
- **From Paige Ave. head south on K Street pull to westside of K Street to wait for entry at the North gate of Tulare Sales Yard to unload your heifer.**
- All exhibitors need to have a transportation slip and vet check in hand at the time of arrival to qualify for 2020 Tulare County Fair Dairy Heifer Sale.
- Each exhibitor is allowed **one adult to accompany them to the sales yard**. If you are not an exhibitor or an adult accompanying an exhibitor, you are not allowed at the sales yard. This is to limit the amount of people we are gathering on the premises.
- Prior to exiting your vehicle, you will go through a mandatory health screening. Once everyone has passed the health inspection you will be wrist banded, then you and your trailer will be guided to the heifer unloading area. If one person in the vehicle fails, the health screening the entire vehicle/trailer including the animals leave the premises and will not be sold in that evening's sale.
- You may bring a bucket to water your animal, a comb, a halter, and yourself. No other tack is allowed on the premises.
- All exhibitors are required to wear face covering.
- All exhibitors need to be in uniform when arriving to the sale yard.
- Tulare County Fair is doing everything possible to get your heifers sold in a live auction format and thanks to the Tulare Sales Yard for hosting a special auction for our youth exhibitors. You have produced an essential commodity for this community, and you should be proud.
- **You will not have contact with your buyer directly after the auction this year.** When your lot is sold you will walk your animal through the sales ring, your animal will be sold, and you will then need to leave the premises. If you wish to deliver a buyer thank you, you will need to do that at a later date, which we definitely encourage you to do, but due to social distancing we cannot allow you back in the sale barn once you have sold your heifer. This will be explained to the buyers and they will understand.
- **Parents you will be able to enter the sale barn when it is your child's turn to sell and you will need to exit when your child is done selling. Please realize we are doing our best to accommodate everyone and we are also trying to socially distance everyone and keep everyone safe.**
- Exhibitors- You will receive a seller's statement in the mail with the name and address of your buyer and all those that supported you with add-ons in the 2020 Tulare County Fair Junior Livestock Auction. You will need to deliver thank you cards, addressed and stamped to the Tulare County Fair office to receive your auction checks. Once all thank you cards have been marked off the list you will receive your check.
- Checks will be available starting Monday, October 5, 2020
- If you have a buyer and choose not to participate and wish to pull your heifer from the sale email jmason@tcfair.org to scratch your entry by Monday, September 14, 2020, by 5pm.
- **Please realize we have jumped through hoops to make this possible for you in 2020 and we will not tolerate any rules to be broken. If we find you in violation of any rules you will not be eligible for the 2021 Tulare County Fair and there will be no exceptions to this rule.**
- The auction will start promptly at 6pm.
